







Figure 5: Central Nervous System Cancers: relative survival proportion by sex, Belgium 2017-2021




Figure 6: Central Nervous System Cancers: relative survival proportion by age group in males, Belgium 2017-2021




Figure 7: Central Nervous System Cancers: relative survival proportion by age group in females, Belgium 2017-2021




Figure 8: Central Nervous System Cancers: relative survival proportion by region in males, Belgium 2017-2021




Figure 9: Central Nervous System Cancers: relative survival proportion by region in females, Belgium 2017-2021
